What a busy week the children have had! We thought we would take this opportunity to share some of the exciting learning that has been going on at our school.

On Monday, Little Lifesavers worked with our Years 5&6 children to deliver CPR skills training. They learnt how to recognise choking, back blows for choking, hands-only CPR and how to put somebody into the recovery position. This was a fantastic workshop, enjoyed by all the children. Year 3 children had great fun learning about rocks in their recent science lesson. Using Starburst, Mrs Sparrow showed how the 3 types of rock are formed - sediment to sedimentary rock to igneous rock (heated in hands and cooled) to metamorphic rock, where they added heat and pressure with an iron. Year 2 children wrote amazing diary entries for how 'The Great Fire of London' started, using well thought out expanded noun phrases to describe what it would have been like.

Children in Oak class have been inspired by honesty quotes from famous people, including William Shakespeare and Elvis Presley to create art work reflecting our school value.

Inspired by the book 'Curiosity' written by a local Brighton author, Markus Motum, Holly class designed their own rover this week and are currently writing an explanation text using technical vocabulary, expanded noun phrases and multi-clause sentences to describe its various features.

In Science, Year 1 children have been busy drawing their faces and labelling their senses.

Ash class are making large 3D animal models from recycled materials, and have been learning African songs. Miss Cove is very excited about celebrating these with everyone when the children have finished.
