<p style="text-align: center;"><u>HISTORY</u></p> <p>Create an 'Ancient Greek' style god/goddess for a modern situation – something technological (mobile phones, TV) , modern food trends (takeaways, crisps) , transport, etc. Look at the etymology of your idea to come up with the name of your god/goddess. You could write the god/goddesses origin story or write a description of their physical characteristics, personalities and powers.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>ART</u></p> <p>Create your own Greek monster – Think of the different materials you could use to present your design – paint, pastels, collage, fabric...</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English/Greek</u></p> <p>Learn some Greek phrases (Hello. How are you?
