FREE SCHOOL MEALS

School meals are free for all state school pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 of primary school. These are known as 'universal infant free school meals'.

However, if your family are living on a low income and claiming certain benefits, your child may be able to get a free lunch regardless of their school year (known as 'benefit-related free school meals'). can also provide paper copies of the information, if necessary.


BABY GRAND PIANO
