Another busy week in school with lots going on. I had the opportunity to go out on a trip to Arundel Castle with our Year 1 and Year 2 children earlier this week. They were excellent ambassadors for the school had a great time learning about the parts of a castle, type of castle and vocabulary associated with castles. It was lovely to spend the day with the children and see first hand the benefit of taking our children out for trips and to see our local heritage.
