WORLD THINKING DAY



On Thursday, 22nd February, children who are members of the Girl Guiding and Scouting organisation can wear their uniforms to school to celebrate 'World Thinking Day'. This includes children who are in Rainbows, Brownies, Guides, Beavers, Cubs and Scouts. World Thinking Day is an annual event, celebrated worldwide.

The 22nd February was chosen as the date for Thinking Day because it was the birthday of Lord Baden-Powell, founder of the Scouting Movement, and Olave Baden-Powell, who was the first World Chief Guide.
