### **DEAF AWARENESS WEEK**

It is Deaf Awareness Week next week (1-7 May) and Nero in Willow Class has worked extremely hard to produce a poster, full of his top tips for communicating with Deaf friends. In our Collective Worship, we have been learning about what it means to be Deaf, exploring issues faced by Deaf people and ways we can support them.

Mrs Mac has set a whole school challenge! Together, we are going to try and learn the **British Sign Language Alphabet** and sign our name by the end of the week. It has been wonderful to see so many children signing around the school already! Why not have a look at the BSL leaflet attached and have a go at home? Good luck!

#### **NSPCC**

On Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> May, the NSPCC will be coming into school to deliver a safeguarding workshop to all our Year 5&6 children on the theme 'Speak Out, Stay Safe'. In addition to this, they have provided materials that we will deliver to the other classes.

The programme helps children understand:

- abuse in all its forms and how to recognise signs of abuse
- that abuse is never a child's fault and that they have the right to be safe
- where to get help and the sources of help available to them, including the Childline service

We will start the morning with a KS1 and KS2 assembly, featuring Ant and Dec, who will empower children in knowing how they can speak out and stay safe. These materials are an effective way to support our safeguarding duties and link directly to our E4S curriculum as well as help reinforce key messages about abuse and neglect as part of our school's teaching on relationships.

With the help of their mascot, Buddy the speech bubble, children will know they have the right to:

- speak out and be heard
- be safe
- get help when they need it
