CHARTWELLS NEW MEAL ORDERING SYSTEM

As you are aware, a new meal ordering system is coming to schools in West Sussex. The launch date for ordering meals is Monday 5th December. This week, we have sent home activation letters from ParentPay to all children in Ash and Willow and to children who have a hot meal or a Free School Meal, in Rowan, Holly and Oak. If you have not received a letter, and your child currently receives lunch, please contact us. If in the future, you would like to book hot meals, please contact the school office and we will be able to give you ParentPay activation details.

In summary,

- We have now provided you with your own unique activation code and you will be required to login to the link provided to set up your account.
- You MUST order the exact meal in advance for your child on the days you require them to have a hot meal.
- Medical diets and lifestyle can be selected at the point of ordering; medical evidence is still required for allergies.
- You will book your meals through ParentPay.
- For children who currently receive a FSM or a UIFSM, these will still be free but you must select a meal via ParentPay.
- We will continue to order meals for FSM and UIFSM up until 16th January.
